

THE ST JULIAN'S SCHOOL DIAMOND JUBILEE SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS ENTERING THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE PROGRAMME

Eligibility: Any student meeting the Qualification Stage requirements, who is not in receipt of 50% or more discounts, and who plans to enter the International Baccalaureate Programme at St Julian's School.

Amount: 50% of Tuition fees.

Selection Process:

a) **Qualification Stage:**

- The scholarship is designed to enable academically able students to attend the IB Programme at St Julian's School.
- Internal students: selection is based on the average (mean) of the achievement grades from the mid-year report in Year 11. The ten best students ranked by these grades, who are "eligible", will qualify for the Examination Stage.

External students: those recommended by the Head Teacher of their current school will qualify for the Examination Stage.

b) **Examination Stage:**

Candidates sit the following written tests (taken in March):

1 General paper (1 hour)

3 Subject based papers (45 minutes each) chosen by the candidate from the following list:

English, Portuguese, French, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, History, Geography

c) **Interview Stage:**

A short list of the best candidates from the Examination Stage will go through to this stage. These candidates will be interviewed by the Headmaster, the IB Coordinator, the Pastoral Coordinator of Years 10 and 11 and one Senior School staff member, who will select the Diamond Jubilee Scholar(s).
